

***Mrs. Tittle's Refined Biscuits***

Preheat oven for 10 minutes at **500 degrees**.

Place 3 to 4 T. butter-flavored shortening on cookie sheet that has edges. Place in oven while preheating it. Remove as soon as shortening is melted, hopefully when your biscuits are ready to be placed on it.

2 cups **self-rising** flour

3 T. (1/4 cup) butter-flavored shortening

2/3 to 3/4 c. milk

Using a pastry blender cut in shortening until like coarse crumbs. Make a well in the center; add milk all at once. Stir quickly with fork, just until dough follows fork around bowl. Turn onto lightly floured surface. (Dough should be soft.) Knead gently 10 to 12 strokes, only until dough is not wet. Pat dough 1/2 inch thick. (You do not need a rolling pin). Dip cutter in flour; cut dough straight down—no twisting.

Place the biscuits on the cookie sheet containing the hot shortening, like this: put the top-side down first in the shortening; turn right-side up. They should sizzle.

Bake 10-12 min at 500 degrees.

[What makes these biscuits different than any other biscuit recipe is that they are made with self-rising flour and baked at a higher temperature—500 degrees—and of course, dipped in (butter-flavored) shortening.]
