AND Who Am I?—Knowing and Experiencing God by His Hebrew Names*, author Ann Morgan Miesner guides readers through the stories of real, ordinary women and men as they experience God in their daily lives, so that they too might commit themselves 100 percent to Jesus Christ.

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OVERVIEW OF THE FOUR PHASES OF THE CHRISTIAN'S LIFE

- Abraham left Ur, south of Elam near modern day Iran – the red line is his travels and of his descendants.
 - Egypt is the Land of Bondage; Goshen is where the **Israelites** (Abraham's offspring) settled with Jacob and his 11 sons. Moses led them out of bondage and through the wilderness until they could see Canaan.
 - Purple line is their route in the wilderness for 40 years, going around the same mountain until the older generation died.
 - Blue line is the possession of Canaan, the Promised Land, with Joshua and Caleb as leaders as they crossed the Jordan River—after Moses died.
- The Israelites** are the Jewish people; Ishmaelites are the Arab people descended from Ishmael, another son of Abraham—not the son of promise to him and his wife Sarah.
